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





Art Playdough Characters

Try out this playdough recipe!

Bring the story to life by molding the characters and setting out of playdough!

Ingredients:


- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 1/2 cup salt
- 2 tsp cream of tartar
- 1 cup water
- 1 tbsp vegetable oil
- Food coloring (optional)
- Essential oils or extracts for scent (optional)

Instructions:

- 1. Mix flour, salt, and cream of tartar in a saucepan.
- 2. Combine water, vegetable oil, food coloring, and scent in a separate bowl.
- 3. Pour the wet mixture into the saucepan and stir.
- 4. Heat over low-medium heat, stirring until it forms a dough (3-5 mins).


5. Remove from heat, let cool a bit, and knead until smooth.


6. Playdough is ready to use!


